A vital adjunct to the many services provided by Yad Sarah for the welfare of thousands of elderly, disabled and sick people and their families and caregivers is its Exhibition, Guidance and Resource Center.

Recognizing the fact that most elderly or disabled people and their families are unaware of the equipment, aids and help that are available, Yad Sarah established a model apartment as a public service. Adjoining it is the Yad Sarah computerized resource library, continually updated, and a permanent exhibition of the equipment available for loan.

Volunteers along with professional social workers, physiotherapists and occupational therapists give on-site information and guidance in the fully-fitted and furnished model apartment displaying the range of state-of-the-art equipment and accessories available to allow the feeble or disabled person to function independently at home. In addition, they advise on other community services available to help, and how to contact them.

The center is also an important facility for members of the medical profession, para-medical workers, and social and community workers.

WHAT IS ON DISPLAY?

Among the aids in the model apartment are:

For the kitchen: Modified cutlery, modified cutting boards for bread, meat and vegetables, pouring aids, non-slip plates and cups, gas alarms, modified kitchen (wheelchair height).

For the bathroom: Elevated toilet seats of various kinds, shower and tub chairs (regular and hydraulic), grab bars, special faucets (e.g., for one-handed, arthritis), non-spill urinals.

For the living room: Power chairs, self-assist chairs, reading lamp with magnifying glass attached, chair raisers.

For the bedroom: Sock donners and other dressing aids. Bed raisers. System control device for lights, radio, intercom and TV

Wheelchairs of every description.
